- So why is the study of music important? There have been numerous research studies that show a direct correlation between musical study and verbal competency, motor and auditory skills, reasoning abilities and problem solving.
 - Findings in a 2009 study featured in the Journal of Neuroscience showed that musical experience for as little as 15 months can lead to structural brain changes and result in improvements in motor and auditory skills.
 - A Stanford University study showed that mastering a musical instrument improves brain processing in areas associated with language development, and may have implications for improving language/ reading skills.
 - In addition to cognitive skills, study in the arts develops character traits such as discipline, perseverance, teamwork, patience, self-control, problem solving, and empathy.
